The following are Curriculum Guides for various college admission requirements. Please check with the college of your interest to see if the college is Open, Selective, Very Selective or Most Selective.

## **OPEN ADMISSION**

4 years of English  
3 years of Math (Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2)  
3 years of Science (2 Lab courses)  
3 years of Social Studies  
2 years World Language  
3 Academic Electives

## **SELECTIVE ADMISSION**

4 years of English  
4 years of Math (Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre calculus)  
3 years Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics)  
3 years of Social Studies  
2 years same World Language  
3 Academic Electives

## **VERY SELECTIVE ADMISSION**

4 years of English  
4 years of Math (Alg1, Geometry, Alg. 2 Pre Calc)  
4 years of Science (Bio, Chem, Phys, and another)  
4 years of Social Studies  
2 -3 years of same World Language  
1 -2 Electives taken at Honors Level or above

## **MOST SELECTIVE ADMISSION**

4 years of English (ending with AP course)  
4 Years of Math (ending with AP course)  
4 years of Science (ending with AP course)  
4 years of Social Studies (ending with AP course)  
4 years of same World Language (ending with AP course)  
1 – 2 Electives taken at Honors Level or above

Most Colleges and Universities will also require a score from a standardized test, e.g. ACT, SAT, CPT.

Strive for a positive progression, better grades as you move from year to year and more challenging courses.

All high school grades count in creating a student's overall GPA. Colleges do include senior year seventh and eighth semester grades for admission consideration. College admission considerations include GPA, Test Scores, and Curriculum.

# Standardized Test Scores

Students take various standardized test during their time at Tampa Catholic. The Explore is used as an admissions test. The PLAN is taken during the fall of Freshmen year and is the practice test for the ACT. The PSAT is taken during the fall of Sophomore, and Junior year and is the practice test for the SAT.

Juniors are required to take either the ACT or SAT for graduation from Tampa Catholic. These tests are also required for most College Admissions.

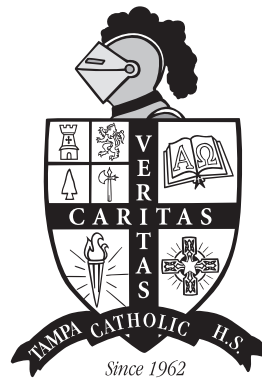
